 - Physical impairment
 - Reading disability
 - Visual impairment
- Regional library of the National Library Service for the Blind and Physically Handicapped (NLS), a division of the U.S. Library of Congress.
- Branch of the NJ State Library.
- There is no cost for any of our services.

- TBBC strives to reach each New Jersey resident who is eligible for our no-cost services.

- Newsline is a telephone-based or internet-based audio news reading service from the National Federation for the Blind (NFB). App for iOS.
- It requires individual registration; institutional accounts are unavailable.
- Individuals can register for Newsline by calling TBBC at 800-792-8322 or online at <u>http://www.nfb.org/nfb/newspapers_by_phon</u> <u>e.asp</u>.

Completed Individual Registration Process

- Completed application can be faxed, mailed or scanned & emailed to TBBC.
- Application is processed quickly.
