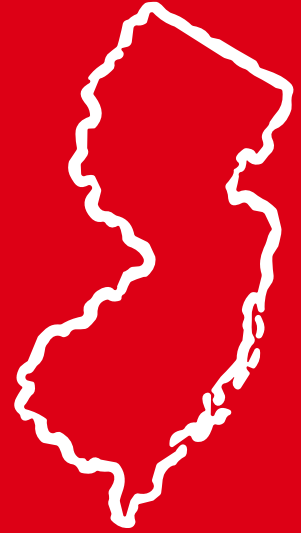


# FAMILY SUCCESS CENTER

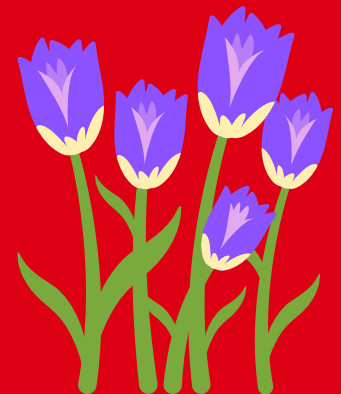
## FREE AND CONFIDENTIAL

**Primary Prevention**– look on building family resilience and stability before a crisis takes place.

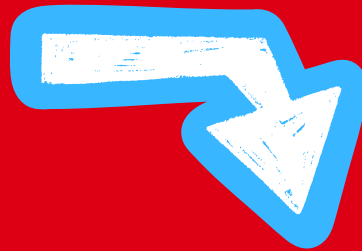
