

NEW IEP

PROCESS

Signed on July 22, 2025, New Jersey's P.L.2025, c. 107 enhances special education transparency by requiring school districts to provide parents with a written statement of the annual IEP meeting agenda at least two business days prior, effective for the 2026-2027 school year.



ALSO

This includes current academic performance, list of excused members with their input, and an invitation for feedback.

KEY ASPECTS

Notice Timeline- Written notice of items to be discussed must be delivered via email and regular mail at least 2 days before the annual meeting.

Documentation- The statement must include the student's current levels of academic and functional performance and any reports or documents to be discussed.

Excused Member Input- If a required team member is excused, their written input on program/services must be provided to the parent.

ASPECTS

Parental Input- The law mandates an invitation for parents to provide feedback regarding proposed programs and services.

Timeline- Full compliance of the changes are required by July 1, 2026 for the 2026-2027 school year.

Working Group- The law establishes an IEP Improvement Working Group within the Department of education to review the process.
